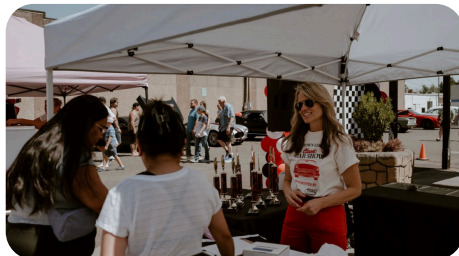
A MESSAGE FROM BOARD

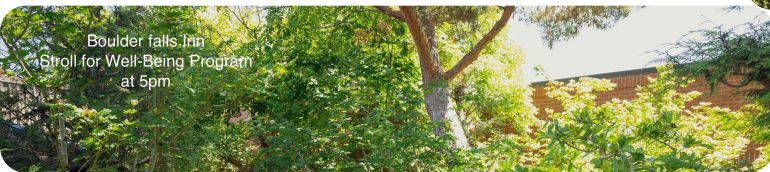

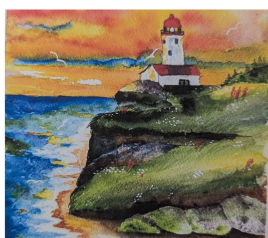

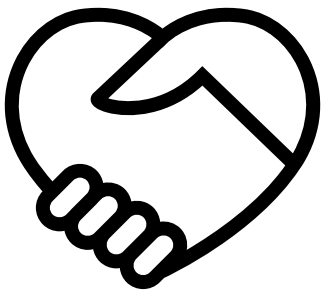
